## About the 2017 RD Summer Institute

Any comprehensive effort requires adequate training, and Virtue-Based Restorative Discipline (VBRD) is no exception. Many existing initiatives that address bullying focus on teaching students strategies for handling aggression. But VBRD is a systemic model that builds an infrastructure for strengthening relationships through the practice of holy habits of virtue. This takes time and effort, but the results are rewarding both personally and professionally for adults willing to learn restorative strategies. VBRD offers a transformative approach to handling the daily behaviors that compromise a positive, productive, and safe learning environment.

The Institute offers a 3-day comprehensive training in virtue education and restorative practices. This combination of skills results in personal transformation and deepens the message of the dignity of the human person for self and others. Adults can then be the true change agents in fostering the climate young people need, supporting safety and academic excellence. Learning and practicing the strategies and skills, participants can then facilitate a way for those who harm others to return to goodness through formation and service.

### **Who should attend the 2017 RDSI?**

Bring a team of administrators and staff. New and returning schools will learn from nearly 200 attendees nationwide.
